On July 19, 2022, the Wood County Sheriff's Department was contacted by a dam operator for a dam which was located on the Wisconsin River, near Wisconsin River Drive and Jefferson Street in the Village of Port Edwards, Wood County, Wisconsin. Maintenance workers discovered human skeletal remains in the water. Law enforcement searched the area and located a skeletonized lower leg with a work boot on the foot and a human skull. Tangled around the boot and leg were the remains of long underwear and fleece pants. In the pockets of the fleece pants were eleven (11) coins of U.S.A currency. The most recently minted coin was a penny from 2016. The work boot is a size 10 Carolina steel toed boot with a Vibram sole.
